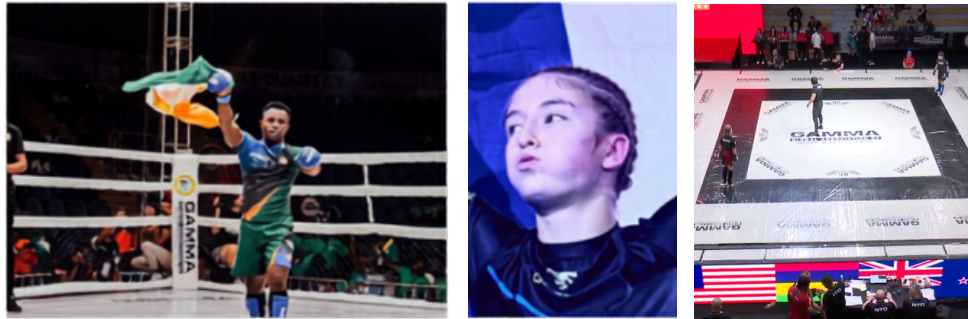


ANNUAL HIGHLIGHTS 2024

This crucial collaboration empowers the ITA to independently oversee GAMMA's comprehensive anti-doping program, ensuring a level playing field and upholding the highest standards of fair play across all competitions.



WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024



The 2024 GAMMA World MMA Championships, held from December 6–14 at the Dewa United Arena in Banten, Indonesia, marked the largest edition in the federation's history, featuring over 500 athletes from more than 70 countries. Organized in collaboration with PERTACAMI and supported by the National Olympic Committee of Indonesia, the event successfully integrated U18 and Senior categories across both MMA and Striking MMA disciplines. This milestone event not only highlighted the exceptional depth of amateur talent globally but also reinforced Indonesia's growing status as a premier hub for international combat sports.

In the final standings, Ukraine delivered a dominant performance to top the medals table with an impressive haul of 17 gold medals, followed by the United States in second place. Host nation Indonesia achieved a historic top-five finish, securing multiple gold medals and demonstrating the significant impact of its national development programs. The championships concluded with a high-profile awards ceremony on December 10, celebrating excellence in sportsmanship and the continued professionalization of the sport as it moves toward greater international recognition.
