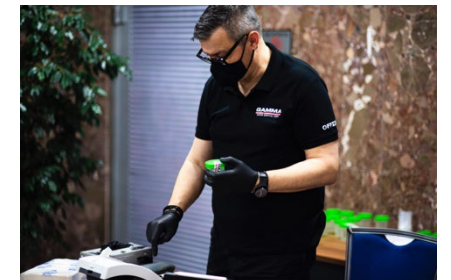

PIONEERING DEVELOPMENTS IN ATHLETE WELFARE

Hydrated Weight Testing: Introduced at the GAMMA European MMA Championships in Kyiv, Ukraine, this initiative promotes athlete safety by discouraging extreme weight cutting, making us the first international sports federation to implement such testing.

Anti-Doping Education: Conducted by the International Testing Agency (ITA) at the GAMMA European MMA Championships, this program underscores our commitment to clean sport and athlete education.



Striking MMA: This new discipline debuted at the GAMMA Asian MMA Championships 2021 in Kyrgyzstan. Striking MMA allows takedowns but prohibits ground and pound, serving as an ideal transition for athletes from striking sports like boxing, Muay Thai, and kickboxing into traditional MMA.
