

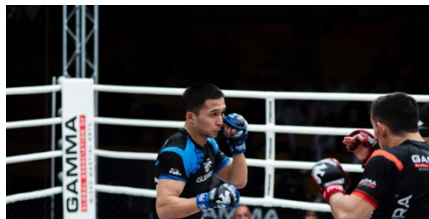
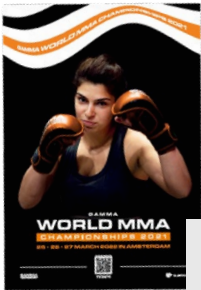
ANNUAL HIGHLIGHTS 2022

A LANDMARK YEAR OF GROWTH AND RESILIENCE

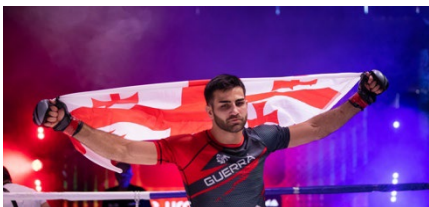

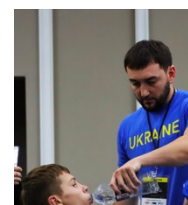
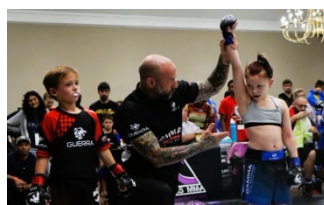
In 2022, GAMMA expanded its competition calendar to an unprecedented four events.



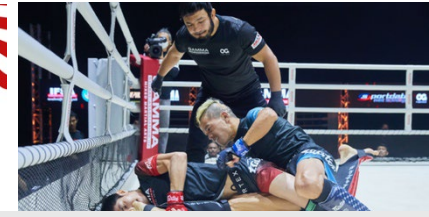
GAMMA World MMA Championships: The second edition took place in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, from March 23-27, setting a high standard for international competition.

U18 International MMA Championships: The USA hosted the first-ever competition for under-18 athletes, showcasing young talent on a global stage.

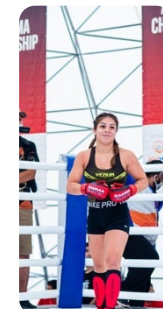


Asian Championships: We concluded the year by expanding the Asian Championships to include Oceania, reflecting our commitment to broadening participation across regions.
