

# 1. COMPETITION INFORMATION



## **1A. Competition Format & Management**

The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the latest edition of the GAMMA Rules & Regulations for International Competitions.

The competition will be managed by GAMMA-appointed officials, including International Technical Officials (ITOs) operating under the authority of the Technical Delegate (TD).

### **Medals & Weight Categories**

Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) athletes in each Weight Category (*Appendix 0*):

- 1 Gold
- 1 Silver
- 2 Bronze

Additional awards may include:

- MVP (Boys & Girls)
- MVP (Men & Women)

A minimum of two (2) athletes must be registered and successfully weighed in for a weight category to be contested.

Athletes acknowledge that, following weigh-ins, a weight category may have fewer than two (2) eligible athletes. In such cases:

- No bout will take place, and
- No medals will be awarded.

Athletes affected may be offered the opportunity to compete in the next higher weight category (maximum one (1) category above the originally entered division), subject to safety considerations and minimum entry requirements.

### **Tournament Draw**

The Official Tournament Draw will be conducted electronically by Sportdata.

### **Competition Equipment**

All athletes are required to use official competition equipment provided by GAMMA, including:

- Gloves
- Shin pads
- Rashguards
- Shorts
- Uniform

Athletes will be assigned red or blue gear according to the official draw.

Competition equipment will be distributed on **27 April 2026**.

Only one (1) team representative is required to collect the equipment on behalf of the delegation.

Competition Surface

- U14 age categories competition will take place on MMA tatamis.
- All categories above U14 will compete in MMA arenas.

## **1B. Competition Categories** (*Appendix 0*)

The Championships will feature male and female divisions in the following MMA age categories:

- U10
- U12
- U14
- U16
- U18
- U21
- Senior

## **1C. Registration & Participation Eligibility**

### **Eligibility**

Participation is open to all National Federations that are members of GAMMA, as well as new national federations eligible for registration as GAMMA member.

Each National Federation may register up to two (2) athletes per weight category.

All registrations must be completed via the GAMMA online database.

- The step-by-step registration process is detailed in Appendix 1.
- Photo requirements for registration are provided in Appendix 2.

Registration Requirements

- All registered team members, must report for registration with a valid passport upon arrival.
- The participation fee is **€100 (One hundred Euros)** per athlete.
- Once payment is completed, the athlete will be moved from the waiting list to the official entry list, which is publicly visible.
- Athletes must hold the nationality of the country they represent and must comply with all GAMMA rules and regulations.

- All athletes must submit the Participation Form no later than **10 April 2026**. This form can be completed here and includes:
  - 1) Medical Liability Waiver
  - 2) Release of Liability
  - 3) Code of Conduct
  - 4) Medical Insurance
- All participants are responsible for arranging their own travel and medical insurance.
- Neither the Organizing Committee nor GAMMA (including its officials and members) shall be held liable for any personal injury, loss, or damage to property arising from participation in or travel related to the competition.

### **Registration Deadline**

The closing date for complete registration, including payment, is **10 April 2026**.

### **Age Eligibility**

- Age eligibility is determined based on the athlete's age as of 28 April 2026, the official competition date.
- There is no maximum age limit for senior athletes. However, athletes over 40 years of age may be required to submit additional medical documentation to confirm fitness to compete.

Each athlete may be accompanied to the competition area by up to two (2) coaches; however, only one (1) coach is permitted to enter the competition area.

All team members must sign the Code of Conduct and Release of Liability in the provided form below

## 1D. Visa & Entry Requirements

A visa requirement overview by country is provided in Appendix 3. Participants are strongly advised to verify the most up-to-date visa requirements applicable to their nationality prior to travel.

The deadline to request visa assistance is **31 March 2026**.

## 1E. Transportation

### International Airport Transportation

#### Athens International Airport “Eleftherios Venizelos”

Airport transportation to GAMMA designated hotel vice versa for listed athletes and officials is provided free of charge by request.

To request airport transportation, teams must complete Appendix 4: Travel Request Form and submit it to:

- [info@gamma.sport](mailto:info@gamma.sport)
- [competitions@gamma.sport](mailto:competitions@gamma.sport) (cc)

Transportation for listed athletes and officials will be provided:

- On arrival: **28 April 2026** (airport to official hotels)
- On departure: **3 May 2026** (official hotels to airport)

A confirmation email will be sent after the submission deadline to confirm successful registration.

The deadline to submit the Travel Request Form is **10 April 2026**.

### Local Transportation

Local transportation will be provided and covered for all teams that:

- Stay at the official accommodation
- Submit complete travel information to [info@gamma.sport](mailto:info@gamma.sport) and cc to [competitions@gamma.sport](mailto:competitions@gamma.sport), no later than **10 April 2026**.

### **International Technical Officials**

Full-board accommodation, including per diem, will be provided for International Technical Officials (referees and judges) who are officially invited by GAMMA.

For all National Technical Officials, full-board accommodation, including per diem will be provided by GAMMA.

**Detailed information regarding accommodation will be updated soon on the GAMMA official website: [gamma.sport](http://gamma.sport)**

### **Important Note**

- All teams must stay at official hotels booked through GAMMA. The LOC will organize daily transportation from the official hotels to the competition venue in the morning and return transportation in accordance with the daily competition schedule.
- Team Managers are required to confirm the total number of team members at least one (1) day in advance to ensure proper transportation arrangements.
- Standard Hotel Check-in Time 14:00 and Check-Out Time 12:00. Guests with late departure flights may store their luggage at the hotel concierge following check-out, subject to hotel policy.

### **1G. Competition Venue**

The GAMMA European Championships 2026 will be held in Loutraki "**Galanopoulos**" **Indoor Sports Hall**, Loutraki, Greece. Further venue details are provided in Appendix 7.

Transportation for eligible teams will include:

- Transfers between official hotels and the competition venue during competition days.

Daily transportation will be informed to all participants during technical meeting

## **IF. Travel, Transportation & Accommodation**

**Official Airport:** Athens International Airport

**Airport Transfers:** Provided for teams staying in official hotels

**Local Transport:** Organized between hotels and competition venue

**Accommodation:** Full-board official hotels in Loutraki

**Note:** GAMMA offer **FREE** to every GAMMA National Federation Members Full Board Accommodation five (5) days, Airport Transfer and Local Transport for:

- President of each GAMMA Country Federation
- Five (5) Youth Athletes plus one (1) Coach (total 6) | SportCamp Facilities
- Five (5) Senior Athletes plus one (1) Coach (total 6) | SportCamp Facilities
- One (1) Technical Official Referee plus Airport ticket

\*\*\* For all extra Athletes full board Accommodation Airport Transfer and Local Transport payment is:

- SportCamp Facilities 70€ per person / per day (3-4 beds)
- 3\* Hotels 95€ per person / per day (2 beds)
- 4\* Hotels 115€ per person / per day (2 beds)
- 5\* Hotels 200€ per person / per day (2 beds)

GAMMA official hotels is listed in Appendix 5

### **Hotel Reservation & Booking Procedure**

To secure accommodation, teams are required to:

- Submit their hotel preferences using the Hotel Reservation Form (Appendix 6)
- Pay any applicable costs.

The payment deadline for accommodation is **10 April 2026**.

The completed Hotel Reservation Form must be sent to:

While teams may indicate their preferred hotel, final hotel booking will be subject to availability. Due to the limited availability, early submission is strongly suggested.

The hotel will be booked by GAMMA for five (5) nights

**28, 29, 30 April and 1, 2 May 2026**

**(Departure on 3 May 2026)**

## 1H. Accreditation

Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival for all National Federations that have completed online accreditation registration.

For all others, accreditation will be available at the Spata Indoor Sports Hall

Each Team Delegation may appoint up to two (2) representatives, preferably the Team Manager and/or Head Coach.

Each delegation will have an appointment with GAMMA Official on technical meeting to:

- Confirm the final entry list
- Verify athletes' names and weight categories
- Confirm that all required forms have been completed

Team Delegation members who are registered through Sportdata within the deadline will receive accreditation on site, subject to confirmation of approved accommodation payment.

### Media Accreditation

Media representatives (journalists, videographers, photographers, and federation communication staff) must apply via: [media@gamma.sport](mailto:media@gamma.sport) (cc: [competitions@gamma.sport](mailto:competitions@gamma.sport))

## 1I. Weigh-ins

- All athletes must complete the official weigh-in by 06:30 in GAMMA official hotel on each competition morning.
- Athletes advancing to semi final and final rounds must also weigh in each competition morning.

## 1J. Doping Control

GAMMA enforces a zero-tolerance policy toward doping and competition manipulation.

All athletes and Athlete Support Personnel must comply with the GAMMA Anti-Doping Rules, which are aligned with the World Anti-Doping Code.

In-competition doping testing will be conducted during the championships. Athletes and Athlete Support Personnel may be selected for testing.

All testing procedures, including sample collection and laboratory analysis, will be managed by the International Testing Agency (ITA) in accordance with:

- The International Standard for Testing
- The International Standard for Laboratories
- The 2026 WADA Prohibited List

### **Anti-Doping**

During the tournament period, athletes may be tested at any time and at any location, with no prior notice, urine and/blood samples.

Each athlete is personally responsible for ensuring that no prohibited substance enters their body.

GAMMA's anti-doping program extends beyond testing and includes:

- Risk Assessment
- Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) management for international-level athletes
- Results Management
- Education and awareness programs

Athletes requiring a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) must complete the relevant application form and submit it to:

[tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport)

### **1K. Medical Care**

Member Federations must ensure that all athletes are covered by hospitalization insurance valid in Athens, Greece.

Emergency medical services, including ambulance access and referral to a local hospital, will be available throughout the tournament period.

### **Medical Checks**

Medical examinations will be conducted at Spata Indoor Sports Hall:

- Upon arrival at 09:00 - 16:00
- Pre-bout
- Post-bout

All medical decisions made by the event-appointed medical doctor are final and binding.

All athletes must submit a Medical Questionnaire, included in the Participation Form (see Section 1C).

## **1L. Insurance**

All participants are required to obtain their own travel and medical insurance.

Neither the Organising Committee nor GAMMA, including its officials and members, shall be held liable for any personal injury, loss, or property damage arising from participation in or travel related to this tournament.

## **1M. Opening & Closing Ceremony**

A parade of participating delegations will take place on the first day of competition (**29 April 2026**). Detailed information will be distributed after technical meeting.

Federation representatives may be invited to the stage during the award ceremonies to present medals to podium finishers and are therefore expected to be dressed appropriately.

### **Award Ceremony Regulations**

- Only official national flags provided following GAMMA standard rules. Each delegation is required to submit two (2) official national flags\* to the LOC for venue display and the Medal Ceremony.
- All National Federation must provide their national anthem (short version) and handed over to GAMMA Official
- Headgear is not permitted on the podium.
- Athletes must wear official national team attire during the award ceremony.

\* The standard size for all national flags shall be:

- 150 × 100 cm national flags
- Material: polyester (110–120 gsm)
- Finish: double-stitched edges + sleeve or eyelets

## General Information

### Governing Body:

Federation European MMA

### Sanctioning:

This Championships is sanctioned by GAMMA and conducted in accordance with the GAMMA Competition Rules & Regulations and all applicable policies.

### Championship Objectives

**The objectives of the European MMA Championships are to:**

1. Develop and promote amateur Mixed Martial Arts across Europe
2. Ensure athlete safety, fair play and integrity of competition
3. Apply unified GAMMA international standards
4. Strengthen cooperation between European National Federations



## **Officials & Referees**

- All referees and judges must be GAMMA certified.
- Officials are appointed by the GAMMA Technical MMA Committee.
- Attendance at the mandatory officials' briefing is required.
- Decisions made by referees and judges are final, unless formally appealed in accordance with GAMMA procedures.
- Each national federation must bring one certified technical official.

## **Technical & Team Leaders Meetings**

Attendance at the Technical and Team Leaders Meetings is mandatory for:

- Team Leaders
- Coaches
- Referees

Key topics referees seminar included:

- Rules and regulation clarification
- Draw confirmation
- Safety procedures
- Protest and appeal procedures

## **Protests & Appeals**

- Protests must be submitted in writing within the timeframe specified by GAMMA (15 minutes) following the relevant bout or decision.
- A protest fee of €500 applies, in accordance with GAMMA regulations.
- Appeals will be reviewed by the GAMMA Technical Committee.
- Video review may be used where permitted under applicable GAMMA rules.

## **Final Provisions**

- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make necessary schedule adjustments, in coordination with GAMMA.
- Any matters not explicitly covered in this Technical Handbook shall be resolved in accordance with GAMMA Rules & Regulations.

## Appendix 3: Visa Overview

### Entry Visa to Greece

Updated: 20 February 2026

Entry visa requirements for European travelers depend on whether the visitor is a citizen of an EU/Schengen country or a non-EU European country.

#### 1. EU, EEA & Swiss Citizens

Visa Requirement: **No visa required.**

Who qualifies:

Citizens of the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA), and Switzerland.

Entry Documents:

- Valid national identity card (with Latin characters), or
- Valid passport

Additional Notes:

- Free entry, residence, and employment in Greece
- No routine vaccination or customs formalities required

#### 2. Non-EU European Citizens

Requirements vary depending on nationality.

##### A. Visa-Free Short Stays (Up to 90 Days)

Citizens of certain non-EU European countries may enter Greece without a visa for short stays of up to 90 days within any 180-day period, for tourism or business purposes.

Common examples:

- United Kingdom
- Albania
- Serbia
- North Macedonia (biometric passports required)

Important Update – ETIAS:

From late 2026, visa-exempt travelers will be required to obtain an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorization System) approval prior to travel.

## B. Visa Required (Schengen Visa – Type C)

Citizens of European countries not included in the visa-exempt list (e.g. Belarus) must apply for a Schengen Visa (Type C) before traveling.

### **3. Long Stays & Residency (Over 90 Days)**

EU / EEA / Swiss Citizens:

- No visa required
- Must register with local Greek authorities if staying longer than 90 days

Non-EU Citizens:

- Must apply for a National Visa (Type D)
- Required for purposes such as employment, study, or long-term residence

### **4. Official Reference**

For the most accurate and up-to-date country-specific visa information, please consult the official list published by the Hellenic Republic Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

## **Key Information for Travelers – Visa & Entry to Greece**

### Visa Requirements Overview

- EU / EEA / Swiss Citizens.  
No visa required and no limit on length of stay. Travelers must carry a valid national ID card or passport.
- Non-EU Citizens Residing in Europe.  
If your nationality is visa-exempt, you will be required to obtain an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorization System) approval prior to travel once the system becomes operational.
- Non-EU Citizens Requiring a Visa
  - Short stays (up to 90 days): Apply for a Schengen Visa (Type C) at the relevant Greek Embassy or Consulate.
  - Long stays (over 90 days): A National Visa (Type D) is required.
- Family Members of EU Citizens  
Non-EU family members accompanying or joining an EU citizen are entitled to a free of charge and accelerated visa procedure, in accordance with EU regulations.

## Visa Application Process

- In many regions, visa applications are processed through GVCW (Global Visa Center World) on behalf of Greek diplomatic missions.
- Applicants should allow sufficient time for processing and ensure all required documentation is submitted.
